



CGRC News – 04/2020 - Coronavirus Update Silverstone National 19/21 March 2020

With the Coronavirus pandemic and bearing in mind Government and Motorsport UK advice* we have decided to make changes to our arrangements for the meeting to mitigate, as best we can, the risk of cross-infection. We are also subject to any decisions, restrictions, or requirements that Silverstone or BARC may have.

In the circumstances, we have decided to cancel the planned Saturday evening social event, as it is an unnecessary congregation of people. In addition, we will not be providing our usual catering for the weekend, except for the provision of tea, coffee and biscuits during each day. As a result, a refund of £30 will be made to weekend entrants and £15 to Sunday entrants.

BARC has issued a statement today regarding their policy should a race meeting be cancelled. It reads:-

“In order to reassure our customers, we would like to stress that, regardless of what may be written in our Terms and Conditions, if we are forced by the authorities to cancel any race meetings or events, we guarantee to refund the entry fees of all competitors, just as we have committed to refund ticket buyers at any of our venues.”

Whilst it is never easy to make these decisions which impact on your expectations and enjoyment of a race weekend these are exceptional times, and we hope you will understand the Club's position.
